Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,
I share with you an excerpt of the Homily of
Pope Francis on Pentecost 2019.

Pentecost arrived, for the disciples, after fifty
days of uncertainty. True, Jesus had risen.
Overjoyed, they had seen him, listened to his
words and even shared a meal with him. Yet
they had not overcome their doubts and fears:
they met behind closed doors (cf. Jn 20:19.26),
uncertain about the future and not ready to
proclaim the risen Lord.

Harmony within human beings. Deep down,
in their hearts, the disciples needed to be
changed. Their story teaches us that even
seeing the Risen Lord is not enough, unless we
welcome him into our hearts. It is no use
knowing that the Risen One is alive, unless we
too live as risen ones. It is the Spirit who makes
Jesus live within us; he raises us up from with-
in. That is why when Jesus appears to his
disciples, he repeats the words, “Peace be with
you!” (Jn 20:19.21), and bestows the Spirit. That
is what peace really is, the peace bestowed on
the Apostles. That peace does not have to do
with resolving outward problems – God does
not spare his disciples from tribulation and
persecution. Rather, it has to do with receiving
the Holy Spirit. The peace bestowed on the
apostles, the peace that does not bring freedom
from problems but in problems, is offered to
each of us. Filled with his peace, our hearts are
like a deep sea, which remains peaceful, even
when its surface is swept by waves. It is a
harmony so profound that it can even turn
persecutions into blessings.

The Holy Spirit does not bring only harmony
within us but also among us. He makes us
Church, building different parts into one har-
monious edifice. Saint Paul explains this well
when, speaking of the Church, he often repeats
a single word, “variety”: varieties of gifts,
varieties of services, varieties of activities” (1
Cor 12:4-6). We differ in the variety of our
qualities and gifts. The Holy Spirit distributes
them creatively, so that they are not all identi-
cal. On the basis of this variety, he builds
unity. From the beginning of creation, he has
done this. Because he is a specialist in changing
chaos into cosmos, in creating harmony.

To be spiritual, to savor the harmony of the
Spirit, we need to adopt his way of seeing
things. Then everything changes: with the
Spirit, the Church is the holy People of God,
mission is not proselytism but the spread of joy,
as others become our brothers and sisters, all
loved by the same Father. Without the Spirit,
though, the Church becomes an organization,
her mission becomes propaganda, her com-
munion an exertion. Many Churches spend
time making pastoral plans, discussing any
number of things. That seems to be the road to
unity, but it is not the way of the Spirit; it is the
road to division. The Spirit is the first and last
need of the Church (cf. Saint Paul VI, General
Audience, 29 November 1972). He “comes
where he is loved, where he is invited, where he
is expected” (*Saint Bonaventure, Sermon for the
Fourth Sunday after Easter*).

Happy birthday to the Catholic Church! Happy birthday to you, who are the body of the Church!

We're all familiar with our own birthdays, and we celebrate them because they mark the day of the year in which we entered into this life. But did you know you have a second birthday?

Because you are part of the body of the Church, Pentecost is the Church's birthday, and yours as well. And like any birthday, it's a cause for celebration.

The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and their followers, and the beginning of their Earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations.

Pentecost is also a Jewish holiday, which the Jews use to celebrate the end of Passover. Jews celebrate the gift of the law to Moses at Mt. Sinai on this day. But we, as Catholics celebrate the birth of our Church.

At Pentecost, the Apostles and their followers were gathered in a room. At this time, a great wind blew and a flame appeared as a tongue of fire, which split itself into many individual flames above the heads of all those present. The Holy Spirit came upon these people and each began to speak in tongues. Despite the fact many had no common language, they were perfectly able to understand one another.

Others who were not so blessed, accused those speaking in tongues of being drunk, but Peter arose and addressed the crowd, explaining that it was only 9 o'clock, and that this phenomenon was not intoxication, but rather this was the work of the Holy Spirit, prophesized in the scripture.

Peter then called all those present to be baptized and about three thousand people were baptized that day.

These people were among the first Catholics, and Peter is the first pope of the Catholic Church.

The symbols of Pentecost are the flame, wind, and the dove, which represents the Holy Spirit. The color of Pentecost is red and the priest wears red vestments on this day. Parishioners are also invited to wear red on this day. Red decorations as well as celebrations are appropriate, similar to any other birthday. Special prayers are often said just for Pentecost.
