Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

Those in front knew what to do. Years ago, a friend shared a driving episode from a cold and windy day. Her car and other cars were in the "front row" at the crosswalk at a red light on Freeway Road (the service road parallel to I-280) in Orange. This road is a high-speed passageway to the interstate.

Just before the light changed from red to green, the wind blew a hat along the ground into the crosswalk. Then, the light changed to green. Seeing the hat, the "front row" drivers maintained their position. They knew what to do and expected a person chasing the hat might emerge. Then, someone emerged, retrieved the hat and returned to the sidewalk. Meanwhile, the drivers behind the "front row" were honking their horns continuously. They had not seen the hat and did not know what to do. Fortunately, the "front row" had set an example.

It can be challenging to be a witness to the sanctity of life, from conception to natural death, to maintain composure, consistency. We turn to God to know what to do. Ours is not simply a legal battle for the right to life of the unborn or the terminally ill. We also want to be witnesses to the developing life of a child starting at conception.

Respect Life Message – 2022

[1. Beginnings of Life] When did your life begin? Your usual reply to this question would be your date of birth. Another way to answer this question is to think of moments when your life has been renewed, re-started, re-booted in some way. Perhaps, your life, when you met your future

spouse. Your life began when you discovered what you were good at in school. Your life began when someone offered you forgiveness for a fault. Your life began when you were able – with God's help – to forgive someone else who trespassed against you.

[2. Beginnings and Cooperation with God] When did your life begin? Sometimes, our life begins when we decide to start over, or to make a significant change. People ask me this question, hey, Padre, hey Father, when did you know you wanted to be a priest? In other words, when did your life begin? When did it start?

In my case, I came to realize – after I had completed my college education and after I was working as a grown-up adult for several years that I felt called to study for the priesthood.

And I'm grateful for the many lessons while working in business environments because I draw on this knowledge in my role as a priest and administrator/pastor.

However, I also recognized that moving out of the business environment and toward the priesthood would be a new life, a new path. This was both freeing and frightening.

Of course, in the official sacramental and church-sense, my life as a priest began when I was ordained at the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark.

There is a verse in the 110th Psalm that applies to God's call to me: -- "Thou art a priest forever – *Tu es sacerdos en aeternum.*" "Forever" does not mean that it was destined to happen even if I objected. In other words, I could have avoided this commitment, if I had not cooperated. In fact, our life begins when we truly cooperate with God's grace.

When did my life begin?

My life as a priest began before the seminary, before college, before there were academics or daily Mass. It began in the "seminary and church" of my home and

hometown with my parents and grandparents and siblings through whom I also learned about love, charity, hope, faith and taking out the garbage and all that stuff. I am still learning about these things from them. I am also learning about these things from you, my parish family. When did my life begin?

[3. Sanctity of Life] When does life begin? This debate has been more public in recent weeks due to the leak - and now final decision of the U.S. Supreme Court -- about the legality of abortion.

And it does come down to a question about when does life begin.

This may not be a question you can answer scientifically or satisfactorily for those who may argue for the legality of permissive laws on abortion. However, I'm inviting you as a Catholic to remember that God is holding you in existence at every moment. You came into this world because you were loved. Are there children who come into this world in horrific violent conditions? Yes. They may even be born to parents who do not wish to raise them or cannot raise them or cannot love them as they should. Nevertheless, it is by an act of God's love that they exist. It is by an act of God's love that you exist, and I exist. And we are called to advocate to care about these lives, to pray for them and to remember that every unborn child, every mother, is important.

They are both important.

When did your life begin?

Your life began in a profound way when you recognized that Jesus is your savior, your shepherd, your good shepherd.


