Dear Brothers & Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes

The Force of Gravity (Part 3 of 3) "When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself." (John 12:32)

In this Sunday's Gospel of Advent, we are re-introduced to John the Baptist, the last of the prophets who proclaims the Messiah. John is preparing the way of the Lord. In this preparation is his partnership with our Lord. He is also drawing people to the Lord.

In the 2013 fictional movie, *Gravity*, there is a crisis for two NASA astronauts, Ryan Stone (Sandra Bullock) and Matt Kowalski (George Clooney), which leads to an important question about how we are to be saved and how we are to pray.

Due to an explosion of shiny and sharp metal, thousands of miles from earth, the two are the sole survivors. Later, Ryan is further isolated and speaking into the radio, but it's not clear that she is audible to anyone. *Houston, we have a problem*.

In this column, I would like to touch on the gravity-pull of the partnership of Ryan and Matt in the movie. Ryan (Sandra Bullock) and Matt (George Clooney) are not married to each other. They are astronauts working together, but I suggest there is something analogous about how we depend on each other, for survival.

The reason Ryan is floating in the space capsule alone and in trouble is

because there was a violent explosion of shiny and sharp metal of a satellite. Stone and Kowalski are the only survivors. Their ability to survive as duo – and reach their destiny – is also defined by their ability to carry out individual responsibility.

In this case, Matt gave up his connection, his tie, and lets go of Ryan's hand, so that she might live. Matt drifts off into space. "There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for a friend." (John 15:13).

But, then – it seems it's all going to be OK because a few scenes later on the way to an apparently very Hollywood ending, Matt is knocking at the window and explaining how to get this "car" started. It's a conversation of hope and renewal. But it was all a dream. But, what is a dream?

I have spoken to so many of you who have felt the presence of a deceased loved one and their guidance is with you. These are examples of hope that our loved ones do live on...and that we can live on.

It requires us also to live in the immediate concerns of the day, of starting the car, of making lunch, of cleaning the house, mowing the lawn, doing laundry, then doing more laundry, of going to work, doing homework, or of escaping back to earth. Ryan Stone is called to this through a symbol of the gravity of prayer, of partnership, and of persistence, and the hope of a life beyond death.

It is Good News that there is a resurrection of the Body, not only of mine, but of yours, and all those we have lost. "When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself." (John 12:32)

Our Lady of Lourdes, pray for us.
