THE JAR OF PRIORITIES I heard about a

teacher demonstrating a life lesson with a glass jar, first filling it with large rocks until no more fit. She asks if the jar is full, and the students say, "Yes." She then adds pebbles, shaking them into the spaces, followed by sand and water, each time asking the same question. When asked what the experiment teaches, one student suggests it means we can always add more to our schedules. The teacher disagrees, explaining that starting with sand or pebbles would leave no room for the big rocks. These represent life's most important priorities. The lesson? Always prioritize the "big rocks."
