Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

Our biblical readings this Sunday remind us that Christ has given us a model to follow which includes taking up our cross each day..

Saint Thomas Aquinas wrote: "Great patience occurs in two ways: either when one patiently suffers much, or when one suffers things which one is able to avoid and yet does not avoid."

I share with you some of the lessons from the readings of this Sunday, in these ideas from each reading: **CONTENTION, COMFORT, COMPLETION, COMMITMENT.**

[CONTENTION] 1st Reading. Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10. "A man of strife and contention to all the land." Jeremiah's experience as a prophet foreshadows the life experiences of Jesus. Both Jeremiah and Jesus land in trouble for their contentions and disagreement with authority figures. In his own way, Jeremiah is "buried" and given a way out. This is the episode and rescue of "Jeremiah in the pit." A prophet in Jerusalem (southern kingdom), Jeremiah lived before the siege of Jerusalem by -- and the exile to -- Babylon . Jeremiah is 57 years old at the start of the exile (587-538 B.C.) The exile ended when the benevolent King Cyrus of Babylon later gave the Jewish people permission to return. In this reading, the exile has not yet started, but Jeremiah is telling the Jewish people that exile in Babylon is better than an alliance with Egypt. For this and other unpopular contentions, Jeremiah is jailed and - in this reading - given solitary confinement in a cistern (well). The rescue of

Jeremiah was made possible by King Zedekiah who originally behaved similarly to Pontius Pilate by letting him be thrown in jail and then in the cistern. Zedekiah does more than Pilate, actually intervening to help: the king ordered Ebed-melech the Cushite to take three men ... to draw the prophet Jeremiah out of the cistern before he should die."

[COMFORT] Psalms 40. "Lord, come to my aid." The Book of Psalms is an excellent place to turn to in distress or need for help. In addition to the 40th Psalm , these psalms speak to us in trouble: 22nd (My God my God why have you forsaken me), 23rd (The Lord is my shepherd), 27th (The Lord is my light and my salvation) 34th (The Lord is close to the brokenhearted), 91st (You shall not fear the terror of the night).

[COMPLETING] Hebrews 12:1-4. "Let us persevere in running the race that lies before us." "You complete me" was a famous line in the movie script written for Tom Cruise's character in *Jerry Maguire* (1996), a sentiment expressing what we hope for in love and friendship. It is also what we receive in Christ, "the leader and perfecter of our faith" (Hebrews 12:2). Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI wrote that human striving for perfection and the parallel idea of incompleteness predates Christian salvation. Benedict XVI reports that a Greek mythological basis of this comes from Plato who indicated that Zeus had split man in two due to pride, thus "[man] longs for his other half ... to regain his integrity" (*Deus Caritas Est*, n. 11) While we acknowledge sin as a source of division, it

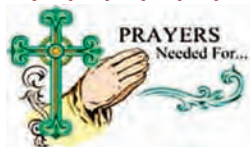

was not inflicted by God, but chosen by us. However, we are blessed for Jesus Christ has taken our sin and punishment upon himself, to restore and to complete you and me, by the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, by Holy Communion, by our sacramental life.

[COMMITTING] Luke 12:49-53 “I have not come to establish peace but rather division.” Have you ever had that “pins and needles” feeling in your hands, feet or extremities? Most often, this is a temporary sensation that does not last. Whether it is short- or long-term, we might describe that our nerves are not “firing” properly. We use the word “fire” to describe many things without smoke or flame. The expression “on fire” applies to a tennis player with a 120 MPH serve or a sprinter winning a gold medal. In fact, their body temperatures are elevated. Water is needed to keep the fire going. We also need the water of God’s grace, the water of the Holy Spirit to fuel our fire and love, to ensure that nothing is holding us back from committing ourselves to Him and his word.
