Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady of Lourdes,

Our biblical readings this Sunday remind us that the message of the Gospel is not just for us in church but for us wherever we are and for the whole world..

Saint Augustine wrote: "Seek what is better than you are so that you can be made better by it. If you desire gold, you may or may not obtain it. But you can always possess God whenever you wish." - Commentary on Psalm 32, 16.

I share with you some of the lessons from the readings of this Sunday, in these ideas from each reading: **POPULARITY**, **PRAISE**, **PRACTICE**, **PROVIDENCE**.

[POPULARITY] 1st Reading. Isaiah 66:18-21 "They shall bring all your brothers and sisters from all the nations." Is being contagious or having a virus ever a good thing? Having experienced the effects of COVID-19 locally and globally, we would respond negatively to this question. However, do we not speak of trends in the economy and society as being "viral"? The Harvard Business Review (Feb. 17, 2014) noted: "There are scores of books written about how to make your content 'go viral' ... [but we] overlook the role of the person delivering the idea: the carrier." Isaiah's prophecy is pointing us toward both Israel and Christ as the servants and carriers of God's message to us, making it known popularly. Isaiah also reported on people bringing offerings to Jerusalem. Isaiah is not simply saying that we must give money to the Temple, to the Church, or to various charities. Rather, the message is that we are to give ourselves -- as we learn in family and friendship to sacrifice ourselves for others.

St. Paul summarized / wrote: "Each must do as already determined, without sadness or compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. Moreover, God is able to make every grace abundant for you, so that in all things, always having all you need, you may have an abundance for every good work." (2 Corinthians 9:7-8)

[PRAISE] Psalm 117. "Praise the Lord all you nations." Imagine you are on the game show Jeopardy!. The category is THE BIBLE. The clue is: "This is the shortest chapter in the Bible with 2 verses and 17 words." You answered. "What is Psalm 117?" You got it right. Good job!

[**PRACTICE**] Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13. "Those whom the Lord loves he disciplines" St. John Henry Newman wrote about the practice of discipline which is certainly extolled as necessary by Jesus himself who said that we are to take up our cross daily. Yet, the practice of discipline is not an end in itself, but a means to the greater purpose of love. Newman described the importance of combining discipline and love: "A man may be most austere in his life and by that austerity learn to be cruel to others, not tender ... self-discipline is a necessary condition but not a sure sign of holiness. It may leave a man worldly or make him a tyrant." (John Henry Newman, "Affliction: A School of Comfort," Parochial and Plain Sermons, Book V, Sermon 21)

[PROVIDENCE] Luke 13:22-30. "They will come from east and west and recline at table in the kingdom of God" Dominican Father Reginald Garrigou-Lagrange, defined "Providence" as God's loving care for men and the need for confidence in Almighty God.

At times, we may lose focus on God as the provider (i.e., "Providence") and focus more on what we must do to provide for ourselves and gain God's favor.

I share these points with you from Catholic Answers (catholic.com) on what the Catholic Church teaches:

GRACE -- God's grace from beginning to end ... justifies, sanctifies, and saves us. As Paul explains in Philippians 2:13, "God is the one, who, for his good purpose, works in you both to desire and to work."

FAITH + WORKS -- James 2:17 reminds us that "faith of itself, if it does not have work, is dead." In verse 24 James says, "See how a person is justified by works and not by faith alone." And later: "For just as a body without a spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead" (2:26).

So, far from teaching a doctrine of "works righteousness" (that would be Pelagianism, which was condemned at the Council of Carthage in A.D. 418), the Catholic Church teaches the true, biblical doctrine of justification.
